Ph.D Duration

- Ph.D Programme Shall be for a Minimum Duration of Three Year, Including Course Work and a Maximum of Six Year.
- The Period of Active Service Spent on pursuing Research Degree i.e. for Acquiring Ph.D degree simultaneously Without Talking any kind of leave may be Counted as Teaching Experience for the Purpose of Direct Recruitment/Promotion to the post Associate Professor and Above.

Eligibility

- A candidate for Admission to the Ph.D must have obtained at least 2nd class in master's degree with securing minimum 55% mark from a recognized University in which the candidate wishes to pursue the programme of research as in a relevant subject.
- A relaxation of 5% marks in PG degree is applicable for reserved category i.e. SC /ST and physically challenge candidate.
